GOVERNMENT EXPANDS SECURITY REBATE PROGRAM FOLLOWING IBAM ADVOCACY

The Insurance Brokers Association of Manitoba (IBAM) is pleased to share that the Manitoba government has announced new security rebates for both households and businesses as part of its recent Throne Speech. The program will provide a \$300 home security rebate and a \$2,500 business security rebate, launching this December.

This announcement aligns directly with IBAM's 2024 Government Advocacy recommendations under Addressing Retail Theft, where the Association called on the Province to:

- Continue collaborative efforts to deter retail theft and maintain the Manitoba Security Rebate Program;
- Expand eligible expenses to include security equipment, training, and cybersecurity tools for small businesses; and
- Consider increasing the rebate amount.

The new rebate levels represent meaningful progress on these priorities. IBAM continues to work with government to advance further improvements to the program, including expanded eligibility for cybersecurity-related equipment, training, and software—areas of growing importance for small businesses across Manitoba.

IBAM recognizes the positive impact this support will have for businesses, clients, and brokers.
